

# V Saaremaa Summer Cup in corona 2011

## Guide

The competition is arranged by **SC Saare Mäng** in collaboration with **LIIVA Sports Centre(Muhu)**, **Saaremaa Valdade Spordiliit** and **Estonian Corona Union (EKML)**.

### I Purpose

To popularize corona and to offer chance to compete.

To find out 2011 Saaremaa Cup winners.

### II Time, place, registration:

- The competition is held from 6th to 7th August 2011 at Liiva Sports Centre

- On 6th August 10.00 individual, ca 15.00 mixed double

- On 7th of August (starts 10.00) – doubles games.

- Registration fee for adults – 3 €, for the young and members of *SC Saare Mäng* – 2 € EEK mandatory.

### III Participants, programme:

- All athletes who know and respect the rules of competition and have completed all clauses of this guide are welcome to compete.

#### Classes of competition:

- girls ( born 1993and later )

- ladies

- boys (born 1993and later)

- men

Competition is in EKML calendar and is ranked.

### IV System of Competition

- The competition is carried out as two tournaments: for ladies and girls and for men and boys.

Men and boys play 7 games in singles competition is Swiss system. The system for ladies and girls depends on the number of competitors. 4 games are played – each game counts.

If there are odd number of competitors, then competitor drawn free for first Sports Centre.

It' starts at 10 o'clock.

- On 6 of August – singles and mixed doubles games.

- Registration between 9.30 and 9.50 at the place of event.

In doubles games 7 rounds and 4 games are played – one point each game.

Men's doubles play 7 rounds in Swiss system.

Ladies doubles system clarifies on spot.

Mixed doubles play 6 rounds.

If odd number of doubles, then the team drawn free for first round gets 4 points and 2 in next rounds.

In round system game played between each other are most important, then comes Berger coefficient and number of wins.

### IV Clauses of participation

- Players must know and respect clauses of competition that are valid in Estonia.

- Each participant must take along exchange shoes and cue.

### V Accommodation

- All expenses related to deputation are endured by participants or their clubs.

- Cafeteria works on spot.

### VI Rewarding

- Top 3 of each event are rewarded with medals and diploms.

Best of each event is rewarded with trophy.

- The arranger has rights to give out special awards.
